### **Arts & Enrichment**

Nadia and Natasha bound off the school bus from O'Hara Elementary, bubbling with excitement as they start what they consider the best part of their day: participating in the Arts & Enrichment After School Program (A&E). They are part of a spirited group of over 70 students from all four Fox Chapel Area School District elementary schools who bring joy and laughter to the Center every weekday from 3:45 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

At the helm of A&E is Director Wade Kramm, who crafts and implements a dynamic year-long curriculum designed to spark curiosity and creativity. Students dive into projects and tackle intriguing questions, such as "How does an airplane fly?" For more than a decade, Wade, along with dedicated teachers Bobbie Cubbage and Stella Petraglia, has been the heartbeat of the program. They are joined by seven other passionate team members who work across six classrooms and the gymnasium, creating a safe and nurturing atmosphere where young minds can learn, play and grow.


### **Fitness**


